

CONSIDERATION OF AP LEVEL COURSES:2017

School policy states:

Any student seeking to take an AP class at UCHS must meet the following qualifications:

- Have a 3.2 GPA in the subject area of the AP course requested
- Achieved a percentile rank average of 70% or higher on achievement testing during the freshman year. The College Board PSAT 8/9 (administered in the fall) will be used to determine scoring. Juniors and Seniors who seek to take an AP class may use any nationally-normed test taken while at UCHS prior to taking an AP course.
- Must meet all course pre-requisites (as noted in Course Description Catalog).
- Teacher recommendation in the particular area of study.
